PATRIOTIC MUSIC FILLS THE AIR IN HOUSTON, TEXAS

May 29th, 2006. Houston, Texas. On July 2nd, 2006, patriotic music will fill the air in Houston, Texas. Lone Star Symphonic Band will be performing an Independence Day themed concert. American favorites, as well as patriotic pieces will be performed. The Band has named the concert "*An American Salute*" and it is the last of the Band's successful 2005 – 2006 Concert Season under the direction of Dr. Clancy Weeks.

The concert will begin at 7:00 pm in the Performing Arts Center of the Houston Community College – Town and Country Campus. Ticket prices will be \$10 for adults and \$5 for children 12 years and younger.

The Lone Star Symphonic Band is an adult semi-professional wind ensemble dedicated to bringing performances of artistic merit to the Houston area community. Founded in 1993 as the West Houston Concert Band, the Band is comprised of musicians of all walks of life and instills the value that music is a life long event, continuing well beyond high school and college, and awards the Jon K. Fisher Memorial Scholarship to students majoring in Music. In the summer of 2005, the Lone Star Symphonic Band entered into a joint venture with Houston Community College – Town and Country Campus, offering the Band as a course for credit to HCC students interested in performing with an ensemble. The Band is under the direction of Dr. Clancy Weeks.
