Lone Star Symphonic Band Holds Halloween Spooktacular Concert

September 27th, 2007. Houston, Texas. The Lone Star Symphonic Band begins the 2007 – 2008 season with a concert of spooky entertainment. The Band will perform a Halloween and Movie inspired concert on Sunday, October 28th, 2007 at Houston Community College - Town and Country Campus, in the Performing Arts Center's Theater #1. The concert will begin at 7:00 pm, with tickets priced at \$10 for adults, and \$5 for children 12 and under. Pieces to be performed at the Halloween Spooktacular include The Alfred Hitchcock Theme, music from the Harry Potter movies, themes from the Star Wars movies, The Phantom of the Opera, Night on Bald Mountain, Procession of the Sardar, and The Witch and the Saint. The Lone Star Symphonic Band will be dressed in costumes for the Halloween Spooktacular concert, and the audience is welcome to join in with their best costumes as well!

The 2007 – 2008 season also marks a milestone season for the Band, as it is celebrating its 15th Anniversary of performing quality concerts for the Houston Metropolitan area. The Band formed in 1993 as a continuing education class for the Katy Independent School District, later branching out on its own, becoming a non-profit entity. In November 2002, the band re-organized as Lone Star Symphonic Band to garner a larger audience base.

The Lone Star Symphonic Band is an adult semi-professional wind ensemble dedicated to bringing performances of artistic merit to the Houston area community. Founded in 1993 as the West Houston Concert Band, the band is comprised of musicians from all walks of life and instills the value that music is a life-long event, continuing well beyond high school and college, and awards the Jon K. Fisher Memorial Scholarship to students majoring in Music. In the summer of 2005, the Band entered into a joint venture with Houston Community College – Town and Country Campus, offering the band as a course for credit to HCC students interested in performing with an ensemble. The Band is under the direction of Mr. Bob Bryant.
